### I. Info

- **Firefox**
- **Edge Chromium**

Please do **NOT** use **Internet Explorer (IE) and outdated versions of Microsoft Edge.**

These browsers are no longer supported by Microsoft, no longer receive updates and therefore represent a security risk. In addition, the web interface cannot be displayed correctly, as they can no longer interpret modern programming languages.


### III. Login


